✓ KEY DECISIONS	<ul> <li>✓ Welcome &amp; Introductions</li> <li>✓ The Regional Consumer Advisory Council (RCAC) meeting snapshot for December 8, 2023 was approved.</li> <li>○ Follow-up agenda items: None</li> <li>✓ The current agenda was reviewed and approved.</li> <li>✓ Joe Wager [MSHN] provided a demonstration of the MSHN Client Portal intended for individuals engaged in MSHN Substance Use Disorder (SUD) services. The portal is for SUD providers who may not have their own electronic medical record system or do not have a way to share information between providers. The portal has resources/links and allows documentation to be signed electronically for individuals engaged in services. More functionalities may be developed once the portal begins to be utilized. The MSHN Client Portal is still in development, and feedback is being sought before a date is determined when the portal will begin to be used by providers.</li> <li>✓ Brie Elsasser [MSHN] presented on the 1915(i) State Plan Amendment. On October 1, 2019, the Centers for Medicare &amp; Medicaid Services (CMS) approved Michigan's request to move specialty behavioral health services under the 1915(i) State Plan. On October 1, 2023, the transition went into effect for the 1915(i) State Plan. Eligibility is determined through an evaluation and person-centered planning process by the CMHSP. The population served are individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability, serious emotional disturbance, or serious mental illness. Eligibility is needs-based and involves a substantial functional limitation in self-care, communication, learning, mobility, self-direction, capacity for independent living, or economic self-sulficiency. The 1915(i)SPA services include Community Living Supports, Enhanced Pharmacy, Environmental Modifications, Family Support &amp; Training, Financial Management, Housing Assistance, Respite, Skill Building, Specialized Medical Equipment &amp; Supplies, Supported Employment, and Vehicle Modifications. Members asked questions on eligibility</li></ul>

	<ul> <li>An update was provided on Conflict Free Access and Planning. MDHHS is expected to issue their plan for Conflict Free Access and Planning soon. MDHHS has considered the feedback provided by individuals served and the provider network. It is unknown what the plan will be or how it will impact the structure that is currently in place.</li> <li>The vice-chair from Gratiot Integrated Health Network has discontinued his involvement with the RCAC. The current chair announced he would need to step down also. Members considered the opportunity, and a member from Montcalm Care Network was elected as the Chair.
